## WHAT HAS NAPEF DONE THIS YEAR?

The following recaps the various grants and scholarship programs administered by the NAP Educational Foundation. These are the keystones to fulfilling its mission.

### Education Development Grants: \$46,730

NAPEF grants are available to associations and units for developing and implementing innovative education programs. The Foundation approved grants totaling \$30,810 in 2018 for the following projects:

- To NAP to design and write new educational materials for NAP using professional instructional designers and writers.
- To NAP to hold courses to train NAP Trainers.

In 2017, NAPEF issued grants totaling \$15,920:

- To Hawaii State Association for the Presiding Workshop and Teacher Training
- To NAP for implementing and training on the learning management system for credentialing
- To NAP for the Youth/Advisor Day
