What has NAPEF done this year?

The following recaps the various grants and scholarship programs administered by the NAP Educational Foundation. These are the keystones to fulfilling its mission.

Educational Development Grants

NAPEF grants are available to associations and units for developing and implementing innovative education programs. The Foundation approved grants totaling \$8,050 in 2019 for the following projects:

- To NAP Credentialing Commission for software update = \$3,000
- To NAP to hold courses to train NAP Trainers = \$5,050

In 2018, NAPEF issued grants totaling \$31,025:

- To NAP Train the Trainer = \$2,525
- To NAP for professionalizing educational material = \$28,500

Scholarship Programs

Supporting young professionals in their parliamentary pursuits is a key goal for the NAPEF. In 2018-2019, the organization issued two scholarships funding NAP membership dues:

It will fund NAP membership dues for the student interns attending NAP's Biennial Conventions upon their taking the membership exam prior to or at the convention. This will enhance the students' experience at the convention by allowing them to participate and vote as members and will ensure they can remain a member the following year.

Educational Materials Development

Produced educational materials on Governing Documents and presented a unit public workshop in San Antonio and an educational track on governing documents for the 2019 NAP Biennial Convention.
