

NAPEF Grants Committee Report
2024 NAPEF Annual Meeting
September 6, 2024 – San Antonio, TX

INTRODUCTION: The NAPEF Grants Committee is charged “to fund & support NAP and others to have educational programs that promote effective meetings”. This year, the Committee has considered all grant applications and recommended approval to the Trustees. In addition, the Committee has: (1) explored different kinds of organizations to benefit from grants; (2) expanded NAPEF’s outreach by increasing other organizations’ interest in grants; (3) and reviewed and revised further its “Call for Grant Proposals”, “Grant Application Form”, and rubrics-measurement known as “Grant Report Guidelines”. All of the above.

As to WORK PRODUCT, the Committee has continued its practice of recommending grants to be awarded by the Foundation, which in recent years have totaled approximately \$100,000. Grantees have recently included NAP for virtual workshops, updates for RONR, 12th ed, credentialing committee video, train the trainer workshops, youth day, NAP interns, the San Antonio Alamo and Registered Units, the Orlando Chapter of Jack and Jill, Inc., and most recently, the Coast Parliamentarians Unit in Houston, TX, and Boy Scouts USA and Missouri Association of Parliamentarians.

Finally, the revised and updated NAPEF Grant Application Form and NAPEF Grant Application Worksheet, both now found on the NAPEF Website, are publicized to be used by members of NAP and outsiders as well. Those application forms are ready for your use, and we on the Committee, and the Foundation, eagerly await your grant application submissions. We look forward to providing Foundation funds for you and your affiliates to help you accomplish new, creative and worthwhile educational programs & materials that will surely benefit NAP and us all.
