



NAPEF CONTRIBUTOR SCHOLARSHIP

Information Sheet

This application is valid annually to fund registration Fees for National Association of Parliamentarian events.

What is the NAPEF Contributor Scholarship?

The NAPEF Contributor Scholarship is an award given to NAP members who have contributed to NAPEF to attend in person the National Training Conference (NTC) or the NAP Biennial Convention.

What is the sponsoring organization?

The NAPEF Contributor Scholarship was established in 2025 to highlight support for parliamentary education by those who have contributed to NAPEF. Activities supporting NAPEF, education and participation at all levels of NAP, and leadership in other organizations are recognized. The NAP Educational Foundation (NAPEF) is the sponsoring organization. NAPEF's mission is to fund and support NAP and others to have educational programs that promote effective meetings.

What does the scholarship fund?

The NAPEF Contributor Scholarship funds registration fees only for in-person attendance at NTC or the Biennial Convention.

How is the application accessed?

The application form for the NAPEF Contributor Scholarship may be found on the NAPEF website napef.org.

Who may apply and how often?

NAP members who have contributed to NAPEF and plan to attend the NTC or the Biennial Convention may apply for the scholarship. An NAPEF contributor member may receive the scholarship award one time.

How many annual scholarships may be awarded?

NAPEF Scholarship Committee may award a limited number of scholarships annually determined by the NAPEF Board of Trustees..

How is the application submitted?

The NAP member who has contributed to NAPEF shall submit the application electronically to the NAPEF Scholarship Committee Chairman.

How will the scholarship be received?

Applications received at least two weeks prior to the early bird registration deadline will be considered as a group. Applicants should delay registration until no-fee registration scholarships are awarded for this group. Applicants will be informed of the results prior to the early bird deadline so that applicants not receiving a scholarship may register at the early bird rate. Scholarship recipients are placed on a no-fee list so that they are not charged the fee when they register. Applications received after the early group deadline and before August 1 may be considered as a group for any remaining available scholarships for reimbursement of registration fees after attendance is verified.
